With Hamilton City Council on a revitalised path to world class Health and Safety, I believe Rhett has helped us by making it real for staff and sharing the impact of a serious injury on an individual's personal, psychological, financial and social life. I highly recommend any business wanting to increase the focus and awareness on safety to invite Rhett to tell his story.
